REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF MATERIALS

The maximum volume of the manuscript is no more than 4 full pages. Materials are accepted in Russian and English. Russians Russian materials are provided, they must contain an English resume, if in English – Russian, respectively.

To prepare the article, please use the Microsoft Word text editor (1997-2003). The format of the A4 set strip. Font size 14 pt, Times New Roman font, line spacing: 1.5 lines, margins above and below 20 mm; right – 10 mm; left – 30 mm, text aligned to the left without paragraph indentation, portrait orientation, without hyphenation. The title of the report in capital letters (centered), on the next line the surname and initials of the authors (in italics), formatting in the center, the next line is the name of the organization, e-mail, lowercase in the center.

Please provide the reference number in square brackets in the order of citation. The cited literature should be given at the end of the message. The font size is 12 pt. Includes: surname and initials of the author/authors, title, output data, including the name of the publisher.

*Example: Sapegina V.F. To the biology of *Ixodes pavlovsky* // Transcontinental connections of migratory birds and their role in the spread of arboviruses. Novosibirsk: Nauka, 1972. pp. 388-391.

Tables in the text must be executed in the Microsoft Word editor (not scanned and not in the form of a picture). Tables should be located within the working field. Formatting of the table number and its name: regular font, size 12 pt, center alignment. The contents of the table are the usual font, size 12 pt, the interval is single.

The drawings are placed within the working field. It is allowed to use drawings in JPEG and TIFF formats. Drawings should allow movement in the text and the possibility of resizing. The scanned image used in the text must have a resolution of at least 300 dots per inch. Formatting of the name and number of the drawing is the usual font, size -12 pt, alignment in the center, the interval is single.

Please do not use headers and footers.
